5th ANNUAL STONE MOUNTAIN PLEIN AIR PAINT OUT

In Stone Mountain Park and the historic Village of Stone Mountain

Saturday, September 29, 2018 8:30 am - 5:00 pm

The Stone Mountain Plein Air Paint Out, now in its 5th year, has become a favorite for artists. Don't miss your chance to experience it for yourself. Artists are the reason we do the Stone Mountain Plein Air Paint Out, and we hope you will join us this year.

The Stone Mountain Plein Air Paint Out is presented by ART Station Contemporary Arts Center and Stone Mountain Park, and artists of all skill levels (18 and older) are invited to compete. Artists may paint in the historic Village of Stone Mountain and in Stone Mountain Park, featuring 3,200 acres of natural beauty, and numerous attractions. Artists may bring friends and family to enjoy the Park and the Village while they paint.

The purpose of the event is to increase awareness of, and appreciation for the scenic appeal of the Park and surrounding community; and, to bring artists to the area. The event also gives area residents and Park visitors the unique chance to watch and interact with working artists.

Artwork may include oils, acrylics, pastels, water media, and drawing media (pencil, charcoal, conte', pen and ink), or a combination of any of the listed materials. Photography is not eligible. All work must be completed solely by the artist, on stamped canvas or paper, on site, without photographic or mechanical assistance, during the period of the paint out (8:30 am - 3:00 pm).

Each artist may submit two paintings for judging by 3:00 pm, which will be displayed on the artist's easel. No framing is required. A reception for the artists will be held from 4-5:00 pm, and awards will be presented.

JUROR & WORKSHOP INSTRUCTOR—GREG BARNES

Barnes received a BFA from Wake Forest University in 1985, studying painting, printmaking, sculpture, and figure drawing. Following college, Greg entered a career path that included technical illustration, computer graphics, computer-based training, and multimedia programming. In 2001, he began pursuing a fine art career full time, and quickly found portrait work, which eventually led him to pastels. He studied with Albert Handell and Scott Christensen early in his professional career. Landscapes are Greg's love. He enjoys painting on location, and as a result of working quickly, leans towards impressionism. A mix of realistic and impressionistic elements give his pieces a life of their own, while a free and creative use of color punctuates his style.

Greg divides his time between working and teaching in his studio/gallery in Charlotte, NC and touring the country, participating in national art festivals and plein air events, and teaching workshops. His work has received numerous awards, and he is represented by several galleries throughout the United States. To learn more about Greg, visit his website: www.barnesstudios.com.

Plein Air Workshop: Friday, September 28, 2018 9:00 pm-4:00 pm

In this fast paced, one-day workshop you'll explore plein air painting in soft pastels, guided by award-winning artist Greg Barnes. Topics covered will range from beginning pointers to how to compose on site and how to get the most out of your materials. Greg will start the day with a demonstration in pastel; however, you may choose to work in pastel or oil. The workshop size will be limited to a maximum of 12, so that Greg will be able to spend time with each student individually. Whether you are a beginner or a seasoned artist, you'll enjoy your experience with Greg.
